### **School Re-organisation Proposals - Consultation**

The public consultation on the school re-organisation proposals that involve Brecon High School was launched by Powys County Council on Wednesday 6 April.

Access to the consultation documentation that has been issued by the County Council is available either via the school website [www.brecon-hs.powys.sch.uk](http://www.brecon-hs.powys.sch.uk) or via the County Council website <http://www.powys.gov.uk/en/schools-students/plans-for-powys-schools/> and then clicking on the link 'Brecon and Gwernyfed High Schools'. This is available in both Welsh and English. Those parents and carers who have specifically requested printed copies of the documentation will receive these through the post.

A questionnaire for responding to the consultation has been provided and it is very important that the County Council receive as many responses as possible so that they are clear regarding the views of the Brecon community.

A version of the consultation document and questionnaire has been created specifically for the pupils. These will be given directly to the pupils so that they are able to provide their own views on the proposals that the County Council are making. They will also have the opportunity to meet with Officers from Powys County Council to share their views.

In addition to responding in writing to the consultation there is a public meeting taking place at Brecon High School at 6.30pm on 19 April 2016. Entry to the meeting will be from 6pm.

Entry to the meetings will be by ticket only which can be booked online through the County Council's website <http://www.powys.gov.uk/en/corporate/find-out-about-consultations-in-powys/brecon-and-gwernyfed-high-schools/>.
