Dear Parents/Carers

As you may be aware, the National Union of Teachers (NUT) have announced strike action to take place on Thursday 21 April 2016. This strike action is a result of a dispute between NUT and Powys County Council.

Strike action would affect the school and this could lead to full or partial closure. At present we do not know which, if any, staff will be taking part in the strike. Staff are under no obligation to inform the school that they are striking prior to the event. This may mean that a decision on whether the school remains open or closed will have to be taken later than is ideal, however we will endeavour to make you aware of the decision we make as soon as possible. I am writing to you now, so that you can consider what plans you would need to make should the school have any form of closure on the 21 April.
